Juvenile Court and Community Schools: Junior High and High School aged classes for Juvenile Court-supervised, probation-referred or district-expelled students.

Special Education: Classes for students with mild, severe, or profound disabilities. Infant to twenty-two years.

Regional Occupational Program: Classes that prepare high school students and adults for entry-level employment in various trades: auto body repair, banking, office technology, merchandising, and others.

- Substitutes who go on to complete a teaching credential are often hired for regular positions.

Position	On-call, as needed, substitute teacher
Location	Santa Barbara, Santa Ynez Valley, Santa Maria and Lompoc.
Salary	\$100/day to start for a full day (4+ to 8 hrs) up to \$115/day.
Credential & Minimum Requirements	Hold or be eligible for a valid California teaching credential plus verification of CBEST clearance. If you do not have a credential but do have a BA + CBEST we will assist you in applying for a substitute permit. New fingerprint verification of eligibility for employment will be required of selected applicant at his/her expense.
